COAL-MINES BILL.

Hon. Mr. Seddon, in Committee, to move,—

Clause 35, line 36, omit the words "a copy of which," and insert "such additional rules may be made to apply to all persons whether acting or employed in or about a mine or not, and a copy of such additional rules."

Clause 75, line 22, omit the word "special" and insert "additional;" line 23, omit the words "general or," and in line 24 insert the words "or additional" between the word "special" and the word "rules;" line 25, omit the words "general or," and insert the words "or additional" between the word "special" and the word "rules."

Clause 76, insert the words "whether or not" between the word "section" and the word "employed;" line 38, omit the word "special," and insert in lieu thereof the word "additional;" and in the side-note insert

the word "additional" in lieu of the word "special."

NAVAL AND MILITARY SETTLERS' AND VOLUNTEERS' LAND BILL.

Hon. Mr. Seddon, in Committee, to move,—

Sub-clause 8 to clause 8, line 9, insert the word "land" between the word "than" and the word "set," and in the same line transpose

the words "naval or" from line 10 before the word "military."

Schedule B, omit the words "of instalments for land held on deferred payments, or for rent of any description whatever," and insert "for land other than land set apart for occupation by naval and military settlers or Volunteers."

FEMALE SUFFRAGE BILL.

Mr. Guinness, in Committee, to move the following proviso to section 2:—

Provided always that only women whose names appear on the ratepayers' roll of any Municipal Corporation, County Council, or Road Board shall be qualified and entitled to have their names enrolled as electors.

Mr. Blake, in Committee, to move the following clause:—

That this Act shall not come into operation until the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.
