GAMING AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. ARNOLD, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Referendum as
to use or not of
totalisator.

4. At the general election next after the passing of this Act the question shall be submitted by referendum to the electors of the Dominion whether or not the use of the totalisator shall be permitted, and if a majority of the votes throughout New Zealand is against the use of the totalisator, then no licenses to use a totalisator shall be granted under the principal Act.
