Gambling Bill

Proposed amendments

Hon Matt Robson, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 62(1)

To insert after paragraph (m) (after line 5 on page 73), the following paragraph:

- (ma) the total number of gaming machines in New Zealand would not exceed the number of gaming machines licensed at 17 October 2001; and

Clause 67(5)

To add to paragraph (c) the expression “; and” (line 22 on page 78), and add the following paragraph:

- (d) the society proposes an increase to the number of gaming machines that it may operate at the venue, and this would result in the total number of gaming machines in New Zealand exceeding the number of gaming machines licensed at 17 October 2001.

Clause 68(5)

To add to paragraph (b) the expression “; or” (line 23 on page 79), and add the following paragraph:

- (c) the society proposes an increase to the number of gaming machines that it may operate at the venue, and this amendment would result in the total number of gaming machines in New Zealand exceeding the number of gaming machines licensed at 17 October 2001.

Clause 82

To insert after the words “operation of” (line 28 on page 91), the words “**sections 62, 67, 68, and**”.

Clause 83

To add the following subclause:

- (5) A society must remove from a class 4 venue the number of gaming machines that exceed the number located at the venue on 17 October 2001 by the close of the day after the commencement of this section.

Clause 84

To omit subclause (2) (lines 3 to 5 on page 93), and substitute the following:

- (2) A society must remove from a class 4 venue all gaming machines by the close of the day after the commencement of this section.

To omit subclause (4) (lines 9 to 20 on page 93), and substitute the following:

- (4) A society must, within 15 working days after receiving notification of the territorial authority's determination of an application for a territorial authority consent, provide a copy of the determination to the Secretary.

To omit subclause (5) (lines 21 to 23 on page 93).

To omit subclause (7) (lines 1 to 10 on page 94).

To omit subclause (8) (lines 12 to 14 on page 94).
