GOVERNMENT RAILWAYS AMENDMENT BILL

## Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Gordon, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 2, subclause (1): To insert in subsection (4) of the proposed section 13B, after the word "regulations" in line 39, the words "not inconsistent with the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952".

New clause 9: To insert, after clause 8, the following clause:

- 9. Repeal—(1) The Government Railways Amendment Act 1957 is hereby repealed.
- (2) This section shall come into force on the date of the commencement of section 2 of the Government Railways Amendment Act 1971.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 2: This amendment is intended to make it clear that regulations made under the proposed new section 13B may not contain any provision that is inconsistent with any provision of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952. This appears to be the correct legal position, but the amendment is intended to remove any possible doubt.

Clause 9 repeals the Government Railways Amendment Act 1957, which is now spent, all the original sections except the Short Title having been repealed.
