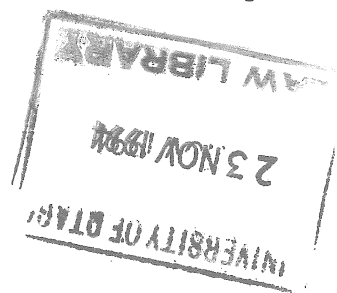

# Supplementary Order Paper

Wednesday, 23 November 1994

GATT (URUGUAY ROUND) BILL

*Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 11 Bills*

Hon. PHILIP BURDON, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part I* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART I AMENDMENTS TO PATENTS ACT 1953" and *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

### **An Act to amend the Patents Act 1953**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Patents Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Patents Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part III* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART III AMENDMENTS TO TRADE MARKS ACT 1953" and *clause 21* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

### **An Act to amend the Trade Marks Act 1953**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Trade Marks Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Trade Marks Act 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part IV* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART IV AMENDMENTS TO FAIR TRADING ACT 1986" and *clause 43* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Fair Trading Act 1986**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fair Trading Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Fair Trading Act 1986 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part V* be a separate Bill and that for the heading “PART V GEOGRAPHICAL INDICATIONS” there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to provide for the registration and protection of geographical indications in relation to goods**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Geographical Indications Act 1994.

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part VI* be a separate Bill and that for the heading “PART VI AMENDMENTS TO ANIMAL REMEDIES ACT 1967” and *clause 66* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Animal Remedies Act 1967**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Animal Remedies Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animal Remedies Act 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part VII* be a separate Bill and that for the heading “PART VII AMENDMENTS TO PESTICIDES ACT 1979” and *clause 70* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Pesticides Act 1979**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Pesticides Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Pesticides Act 1979 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part VIII* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART VIII AMENDMENTS TO MEDICINES ACT 1981" and *clause 73* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Medicines Act 1981**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Medicines Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Medicines Act 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part IX* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART IX AMENDMENTS TO CUSTOMS ACT 1966" and *clause 76* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part X* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART X AMENDMENTS TO TEMPORARY SAFEGUARD AUTHORITIES ACT 1987" and *clause 79* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Temporary Safeguard Authorities Act 1987**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Temporary Safeguard Authorities Amendment Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Temporary Safeguard Authorities Act 1987 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part XI* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART XI AMENDMENTS TO DUMPING AND COUNTERVAILING DUTIES ACT 1988" and *clause 85* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to amend the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Amendment

Act 1994, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council and one or more orders may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part XII* be a separate Bill and that for the heading "PART XII REPEAL OF GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE ACT 1948" there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

**An Act to repeal the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act 1948**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade Act Repeal Act 1994.

(2) This Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.
