MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

By-laws for regulating public advertising.

(13.) In addition to the matters specified in section four hundred and three of the principal Act, the Council may make, alter, and repeal by-laws for the purpose of regulating, controlling, or prohibiting the display upon public buildings, bridges, or other structures, walls, fences, telegraph-posts, lamp-posts, pavements, hoardings, or vehicles, of posters, placards, handbills, writings, pictures, or devices for advertising or other purposes.

IMPOUNDING ACT AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2.)

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move to strike out clause 2 as printed and substitute the following:—

Definition of "nearest accessible pound."

2. The pound referred to in section twelve of the principal Act shall be deemed to be the "nearest accessible pound" referred to in section eleven, and the words "nearest accessible pound" shall in every case mean the pound which is most easily accessible having regard to distance and facilities of access at the time of impounding.
