### IRON AND STEEL INDUSTRY BILL.

Hon. Mr. SULLIVAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 12: To omit the words “(being rights held by the Onakaka Iron and Steel Company, Limited (in liquidation))” in lines 10–12.

[NOTE.—*This alteration involves the omission of the bracket after the word “Nelson” in line 13.*]

Clause 13, subclause (2): To omit paragraph (b), and substitute the following paragraph:—

(b) The Court shall not take into consideration any act or thing done or omitted to be done by or on behalf of the Crown in relation to any of those privileges, and in particular, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing provisions of this paragraph, the Court shall not take into consideration the fact that, notwithstanding default made by the holders in complying with the terms of those privileges, no proceedings for the forfeiture of those privileges had been taken.

Clause 15, subclause (1): To insert, after the words “revoked by this Act” in line 34, the words “(whether or not proceedings in respect thereof have been taken under section *thirteen* hereof)”.
