INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. Steward, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Contracting-out a breach of award.

12a. Every employer or worker who enters into any agreement to pay or to accept a rate of wages or payment less than that prescribed in any award, or in any way whatsoever gives or accepts employment in such manner as to defeat the intention of any award, or to escape the operation thereof, shall be deemed to have committed a breach of the award, and shall be liable accordingly.
