INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRAFION AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Bartram, in Committee, to move to insert the following new clauses:—

Duties of

20. The provisions of section thirty-five of the principal Act Dominion Clerk shall, mutatis mutandis, apply to the Dominion Clerk of Awards and all awards or agreements, powers, notices, applications, and proceedings under the principal Act or this Act or the regulations made under the principal Act in respect of Dominion awards or amalgamated unions exercisable by, or to be made or given by, or to, or filed with, the Clerk of Awards shall be exerciseable by, or made or given by, or to, or filed with, such Dominion Clerk of Awards.

Extension of provisions of

21. The provisions of this Act may from time to time be extended by Order in Council to any industrial association of workers registered under the principal Act upon application in writing under seal of such industrial association to the Minister of Labour.
