THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT FRANCHISE BILL.

Mr. HOUSTON, in Committee, to move the following proviso to clause 2:—

Provided that all electors or ratepayers shall pay the same amount of rates.

INTESTATES' ESTATES BILL.

Mr. HEKE, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Wills made by any person whose age is over fifty-six years shall be null and void.

Persons suffering from any temporary mental or physical weakness of mind or body, or both, shall be considered persons in a weak state of mind, and wills made by such persons shall be null and void.

No person who is under medical advice or treatment, or who may be lying ill, shall be capable of making a will, and wills so made shall be declared null and void.
