## INDUSTRIAL LAW REFORM BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon. Mr GORDON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That *clauses 2 to 12* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

**An Act to amend the Industrial Relations Act 1973**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Industrial Relations Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial Relations Act 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 13 to 15* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 13* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

**An Act to amend the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the State Services Conditions of Employment Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the State Services Conditions of Employment Act 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 16 to 18* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 16* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

**An Act to amend the Aircrew Industrial Tribunal Act 1971**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Aircrew Industrial Tribunal Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Aircrew Industrial Tribunal Act 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Industrial Law Reform Bill into three separate amending Acts.
