INSURANCE LAW REFORM BILL (NO. 2)

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon. GEOFFREY PALMER, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That *clauses 17 and 18* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 17* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

**An Act to amend the Friendly Societies and Credit Unions Act 1982**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Friendly Societies and Credit Unions Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Friendly Societies and Credit Unions Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1986.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Insurance Law Reform Bill (No. 2) into two parts so that *clauses 17 and 18* may be enacted as the Friendly Societies and Credit Unions Amendment Act 1985.
