

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Friday, the 7th day of August, 1874.

Mr. O'NEILL, in Committee on Inspection of Machinery Bill, to move the following clause (to be inserted between 11th and 12th clauses) :—

No person in charge of boilers or machinery shall be employed more than eight hours in any one day as an ordinary day's work.

The Honourable Mr. VOGEL to move the following amendments to New Zealand Forests Bill :—

In the preamble, line 3, page 2, to omit all the words commencing "And whereas," inclusive, to the end of the preamble.

Section 2, omit the whole.

Section 3, omit lines 38 and 39.

Section 4, omit all the words commencing "out of any excess," inclusive, line 56, to the end of the section.

Section 5, omit the whole.

Section 8, omit all the words from the commencement of the section to the end of line 8 on page 4, and in lieu thereof to insert the following words :—"The State Forests shall consist of such lands as the General Assembly shall hereafter from time to time determine, and of such lands within any province as the Superintendent of any province, on the recommendation of the Provincial Council of such province, shall in the meanwhile request the Governor to set apart for the purpose; and the revenues arising from such lands shall be paid to the "State Forests Account."

The remainder of section 8, from line 9 to 19, both inclusive, to stand as a separate clause.

Page 4, line 9, to omit the word "selected" and insert in lieu thereof the words "so set apart."

Sections 9 to 19 inclusive, to omit the whole.

Section 23, to omit the whole.
