INLAND REVENUE OFFENCES BILL

[This Supplementary Order Paper is in substitution for Supplementary Order Paper No. 11 dated Wednesday, 9 April 1986.]

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. R. O. DOUGLAS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That clauses 2, 3, 4, and 5 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title and commencement:

An Act to amend the Inland Revenue Department Act 1974

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Inland Revenue Department Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Inland Revenue Department Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1986 and apply to offences committed on or after that date.

(3) Any proceedings commenced (whether before or after the commencement of this Act) for an offence committed before the commencement of this Act shall be heard and determined as if this Act had not been enacted.

That clauses 6, 7, and 8 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 6 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title and commencement:

An Act to amend the Land Tax Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Land Tax Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Land Tax Act 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1986 and apply to offences committed on or after that date.

(3) Any proceedings commenced (whether before or after the commencement of this Act) for an offence committed before the commencement of this Act shall be heard and determined as if this Act had not been enacted.

That clauses 9 and 10 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 9 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title and commencement.

An Act to amend the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Estate and Gift Duties Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Estate and Gift Duties Act 1968 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1986 and apply to offences committed on or after that date.

(3) Any proceedings commenced (whether before or after the commencement of this Act) for an offence committed before the commencement of this Act shall be heard and determined as if this Act had not been enacted.
