INDUSTRIAL SCHOOLS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Major Steward, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

It shall not be lawful for the manager of, or any person in authority or employed in, any industrial school, to confine any inmate in any dark room for any offence whatsoever; and no inmate of any such institution shall, as a punishment for insubordination or other misconduct, or for any breach of the rules, be placed on a bread-and-water diet for a longer period than forty-eight hours; and any manager or other person who shall be guilty of a breach of this provision shall, on conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty of not less than five pounds and not exceeding fifty pounds.
