Judicial Matters Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 11 Bills

Hon Margaret Wilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That clauses 1 and 2, Part 1, and Schedules 1AA and 1 be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, clauses 1 and 2, and the Part 1 heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Judicial Conduct Commissioner and Judicial Conduct Panel Act 2004.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made appointing different dates for different provisions and different purposes.

That *clauses 36 to 38* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and the heading before *clause 36* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989¹ is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clause 39* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 39* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Coroners Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Coroners Act 1988² is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clause 40* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 40* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- (2) In this Act, the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953³ is called "the principal Act".

- (1) This Act is Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, Te-Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993¹⁰ is called "the principal Act".
