### Judicial Matters Bill

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 11 Bills*

Hon Margaret Wilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 1 and 2, Part 1, and Schedules 1AA and 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

- 1 Title**  
This Act is the Judicial Conduct Commissioner and Judicial Conduct Panel Act **2004**.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made appointing different dates for different provisions and different purposes.

That *clauses 36 to 38* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and the heading before *clause 36* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

- 1 Title**
  - (1) This Act is the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Amendment Act **2004**.
  - (2) In this Act, the Children, Young Persons, and Their Families Act 1989<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clause 39* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 39* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Coroners Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Coroners Act 1988<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>2</sup> 1988 No 111

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clause 40* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 40* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Courts Martial Appeals Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Courts Martial Appeals Act 1953<sup>3</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>3</sup> 1953 No 100

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 41 to 45* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 41* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the District Courts Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the District Courts Act 1947<sup>4</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>4</sup> 1947 No 16

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 46 to 48* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 46* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Employment Relations Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Employment Relations Act 2000<sup>5</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>5</sup> 2000 No 24

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 49 and 50* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 49* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Family Courts Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Family Courts Act 1980<sup>6</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>6</sup> 1980 No 161

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 51 to 60 and Schedule 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 51* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Judicature Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Judicature Act 1908<sup>7</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>7</sup> 1908 No 89

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 61 to 65* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 61* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Resource Management Amendment Act **2004**.

- (2) In this Act, the Resource Management Act 1991<sup>8</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>8</sup> 1991 No 69

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 66 to 71* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 66* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Summary Proceedings Amendment Act **2004**.  
(2) In this Act, the Summary Proceedings Act 1957<sup>9</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>9</sup> 1957 No 87

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 72 to 75* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading before *clause 72* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act **2004**.  
(2) In this Act, Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993<sup>10</sup> is called “the principal Act”.  
<sup>10</sup> 1993 No 4

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
