JUSTICES OF THE PEACE ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Major STEWARD to move, That the Bill be recommitted for the reconsideration of the following new clause, added on the motion of Hon. Sir J. Hall:—

“The authority to take and receive a statutory declaration, conferred by the two hundred and thirty-fourth section of the said Act, shall extend to and include any person holding the office of Post-master under ‘The Post Offices Act, 1881,’ whom the Governor may, from time to time, by a notification in the *Gazette*, declare authorised for that purpose.”

With a view to add, at the end thereof, the words following, that is to say,—

“And any affidavit required by ‘The Chattel Securities Act, 1880,’ or any amendment thereof, may be sworn before such post-master.”
