KAURI-GUM INDUSTRY BILL.

Mr. Lethbridge, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

Any holder of a gum-digging license who has resided for a period of six months in the district in which such license has been issued shall be entitled to vote at any election of members of the local body issuing such license.

ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. O'REGAN, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:-

5. (1.) No person shall introduce or liberate upon Stewart Island, or any other island adjacent to the mainland of the colony, any stoat, weasel, ferret, cat, or other animal destructive to game or native game.

(2.) Every person offending against the provisions of this section shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding one hundred pounds, and in default of payment to be imprisoned for a period of not more than

six months.
