NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

LICENSING ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. GEORGE, in Committee, to move the addition of the following subsections to section 5 :—

- (1.) For every license to be granted to any keeper of a refreshment or accommodation house to sell therein, by retail, colonial wine to be consumed in such house, or on the premises belonging thereto, the licensee shall pay an annual license fee of Three pounds three shillings ;
- (2.) And for every license to be granted to sell, by retail, colonial wine in any house, or on the premises belonging thereto where such wine is manufactured, the licensee shall pay an annual license fee of Two pounds two shillings ;
- (3.) And for every license to be taken out by any person for the selling of colonial wine, in the house or on the premises where such wine is manufactured, the licensee shall pay an annual license fee of One pound one shilling.
- (4.) "Colonial wine" shall mean, for the purposes of this Act, wine manufactured within the limits of the colony of New Zealand, and not containing a greater proportion than thirty per centum of proof spirit.
