LAND ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Major Steward, in Committee, to move the following addition to clause 9:—

Copies of such description, together with maps showing in distinct colours the lands so classified, shall be supplied to every County Council, Road Board, Borough Council, and Town Board throughout the districts wherein any of the said lands are situated, and shall also be displayed for public information at every post-office and railway-station within such districts.

Mr. T. Thompson, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Within six months after the passing of this Act the Minister of Lands shall cause a report and plans to be prepared by the Surveyor-General, showing what lands within the colony are best adapted for laying off as village-settlements under the regulations published in *Gazette* number forty-five, of the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, pages one thousand and fifty-three and one thousand and fifty-four, or any amendments heretofore or hereafter to be made, and the Minister in each year shall cause all necessary steps to be taken to set aside such of the aforesaid lands as he may consider most suitable for the purpose of such settlements, and so that in each year he shall cause to be so set aside not less than ten thousand acres in the whole.
