LAND ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. Steward, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

In any case wherein it is shown to the satisfaction of the Land Board that by the encroachment of a river or stream the area of land held by any tenant of the Crown under perpetual lease or lease in perpetuity has been materially reduced, it shall be competent to the Board to reduce the annual rental payable by such tenant to an extent corresponding with such reduction in area.
