LICENSING ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Moss, in Committee, to move the following new clauses :—

No dealer to be in possession of impure liquor.

A. Every brewer or wholesale or retail licensed person who shall have in his possession any beer, ale, or porter consisting of less than ninety per centum of the product of malt and hops, or shall have in his possession any spirits, wine, beer, ale, or porter containing more than five per centum of deleterious chemicals, shall be liable for each offence to a penalty not exceeding *one hundred* pounds.

Lease to be produced before Committee can renew license.

B. No Committee shall have jurisdiction to grant a license or the renewal of a license to any person, except the owner of the premises to which such license shall apply, unless such person shall produce a lease of the said premises for the term of the said license at a rental not exceeding *twenty* pounds per centum per annum of the true value of the said premises free from all rates, taxes, and insurances, and free from conditions restricting his purchase of any commodity.
