## LICENSING ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Extraordinary vacancies on Licensing Committees.

- A. (1.) Every member of a Licensing Committee who, by writing under his hand addressed to the Chairman, resigns his office, or who becomes disqualified, or is absent from two consecutive quarterly licensing meetings of the Committee, shall immediately cease to be a member of the Committee.
- (2.) Where the office of a member of a Licensing Committee becomes vacant from any of the causes aforesaid or from death such vacancy shall be deemed to be an extraordinary vacancy, and the Governor shall appoint some person to fill the same, who shall hold office only until the next election of a Licensing Committee.

(3.) This section is in substitution for paragraphs (10), (11), and (12) of section seven of the Amendment Act of 1893, which paragraphs are hereby accordingly repealed.
