LICENSING ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. TAYLOR, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

It shall not be lawful for the holder of any license for the sale of liquor under this or any other Licensing Act to sell, dispose of, or deliver any tobacco, cigars, or cigarettes on any day or portion of a day which has been set apart for the purposes of a public holiday under the Shops and Shop-assistants or other Act. Any licensee guilty of a breach of this provision shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds.

Mr. Bedford, in Committee, to move the following new clause:-

The third proviso in section four of "The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act Amendment Act, 1895," is hereby amended by substituting the word "one-third" for the word "one-half."
