LEGISLATURE AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Quaternal
Parliaments.

A. Every House of Representatives elected after the passing of this Act shall, unless the General Assembly is sooner dissolved, continue for a period of *four* years, computed from the day fixed for the return of the writs issued for choosing such House, and no longer.

B. Subsection two of section thirteen of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
