### LEGISLATURE AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Section 18 of  
principal Act  
amended.

*A.* Section eighteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words “five hundred and fifty” in the fifth line thereof, and substituting therefor the words “fifteen hundred.”

Duration of  
Parliament.

*B.* Every House of Representatives elected after the passing of this Act shall, unless the General Assembly be sooner dissolved, continue for a period of *four* years, computed from the day fixed for the return of the writs issued for choosing such House, and no longer.

Repeal.

Subsection two of section thirteen of the principal Act is hereby repealed.
