LAND AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir W. J. Steward, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Amendment of section 347 of principal Act. A. (1.) Section three hundred and forty-seven of the principal Act (excepting certain interests from the operation of Part XIII) is hereby amended by adding the following paragraphs thereto:—

" (d.) Any interest acquired under sections eleven, one hundred and forty, or one hundred and forty-two of this Act:

"(e.) Any interest acquired in respect of land received from the Crown or any local authority pursuant to any contract or arrangement for exchange of land for roads or any public purpose:

"(f.) Any interest acquired in respect of land formerly used or laid off as a road, but subsequently closed or stopped (whether under the provisions of the Public Works Act or any other enactment) and sold to any person."

(2.) The foregoing paragraphs (d), (e), and (f) shall be retroactive, and shall apply to all interests acquired since the date of the coming into operation of the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1907; and any memorandum under section three hundred and forty-six of the Land Act, 1908, or any certificate of title for any such interest shall, on application to the District Land Registrar, be removed or cancelled.
