### LICENSING AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. McCOMBS, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 4, subclause (1): In lines 43, 44, 45, 46, and 47, to strike out all the words down to and including the words “national prohibition,” with a view to inserting the following words:—

“Whenever at a licensing poll held under the foregoing provisions of this Act there is an absolute majority of valid votes recorded for either national prohibition or national continuance the proposal for which there is an absolute majority of valid votes recorded”
