LEGAL AID BILL

Proposed Amendments

Right Hon. Mr MARSHALL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 15, subclause (1): To insert, after paragraph (f), the following paragraph:

(ff) Appeals to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council in civil proceedings in any case where—

(i) The applicant has succeeded in the Court of Appeal and is the respondent in the appeal to the Privy Council, if the grant of aid is approved by the Minister; or

(ii) The Attorney-General certifies that a question of law of exceptional public importance is involved and that the grant of aid is desirable in the public interest:

Clause 15, subclause (3): To insert in line 39 on page 10, after the expression “paragraph (f)”, the expression “paragraph (ff)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The amendments make provision for legal aid in respect of certain appeals to the Privy Council.
