## Proposed Amendments

Right Hon. Mr Marshall, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 15, subclause (1): To insert, after paragraph (f), the following paragraph:

(ff) Appeals to the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council in civil proceedings in any case where—

> (i) The applicant has succeeded in the Court of Appeal and is the respondent in the appeal to the Privy Council, if the grant of aid is approved by the Minister; or

> (ii) The Attorney-General certifies that a question of law of exceptional public importance is involved and that the grant of aid is desirable in the public interest:

Clause 15, subclause (3): To insert in line 39 on page 10, after the expression "paragraph (f)", the expression "paragraph (ff)".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

The amendments make provision for legal aid in respect of certain appeals to the Privy Council.
