LEGISLATURE AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Mr. McCallum, in Committee, to move the following new clause:---

A. The Governor-General may, by Order in Council duly gazetted, make full provision for all patients attended by duly qualified medical practitioners recording their votes at all general and licensing election polls. Such provision may be similar to the right at present granted to seamen, or by means of a Returning Officer or some delegate appointed by him waiting upon the patient for the purpose of enabling him to record such vote.
