LICENSING AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Mr. H. G. R. MASON, in Committee, to move to add the following new clauses :—

Section 11 of
Licensing
Amendment Act,
1914, amended.

A. Section eleven of the Licensing Amendment Act, 1914, is hereby amended as follows—that is to say, subsection eight is amended by inserting the words “or the manufacture of another holder of a wine-maker’s license” after the words “his own manufacture.”

B. Subsection eight of section eleven is further amended by striking out the words “two gallons,” and by substituting in place thereof the words “one reputed quart.”

C. Subsection eight of section eleven is further amended by striking out the words “from one place only as specified in the license,” and inserting in their place the words “from such place or places only as the Magistrate upon the granting of the license may determine and may specify in the license, and application may be made at any time by the holder of a winemakers’ license for an additional place to be specified from which wine may be delivered ; such application to be made, dealt with, and determined in the same manner as if it were an application for a winegrower’s license ; and in the event of the application being granted the applicant’s winegrower’s license shall be amended by the Magistrate accordingly.”
