LUNATIC ASYLUMS BOARD OF INQUIRY BILL.

Mr. G. W. RUSSELL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2, line 16: Strike out the words “may be, but,” and “necessarily.” The parenthetical clause will then read “who shall not be an employé at the asylum.”

Clause 4: Strike out clause as printed in the Bill, and, in lieu thereof, insert the following:—

4. Upon hearing the appeal, the Board shall make such recommendation as in its opinion the circumstances warrant. A copy of such recommendation shall be forwarded respectively to the appellant, the medical officer in charge, and to the Minister in charge of lunatic asylums: Provided that the Minister may accept, modify, or disallow such recommendation.
