## MINING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. R. H. J. REEVES, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

If the rent of any licensed holding, special claim, or lease, be not paid within six months of its due date a fine of ten per centum shall be imposed; and if not paid within two years the said licensed holding, special claim, or lease, shall be forfeited.

It shall be lawful for the Warden to suspend the operation of any of the provisions of this Act with respect to the employment of men on any licensed holding, special claim, or lease, for any term not exceeding twelve months, upon application made by lessee, and after hearing objection, if any; such application to be advertised.

To move the following amendments:—

Strike out subclause (c) in Amendment Bill.

Strike out clause 60 of principal Act.

## LAND- AND INCOME-ASSESSMENT ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. FISHER, in Committee, to move, That Schedule A of the Act of 1891 be amended to read as follows:—

1. Every person and company being the owner of land shall be liable to tax in accordance with this Act, and such tax shall be assessed and levied upon the actual value of such land; but the value of improvements upon all land owned by any person or company up to *one* thousand pounds shall be deducted from such assessed value, and any mortgage then due or owing upon such land shall also be deducted from such value.
