LAND AND INCOME ASSESSMENT ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Massey, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

A. Where the interest paid by the mortgager to the mortgagee on the sum secured by any mortgage does not exceed five per centum per annum, the mortgagee shall be exempt from taxation under the Assessment Acts in respect of the amount of such mortgage.

B. Where the amount secured by a mortgage exceeds the unimproved value of the mortgaged land, the mortgagee shall be liable to pay mortgage-tax on the amount of the unimproved value only.

SUPPLY.

Mr. MILLAR, on going into Committee, to move:—

That, in the opinion of this House, the excise duty on colonial beer should

be increased from threepence to sixpence per gallon.

That, in the opinion of this House, the duty on port and sherry wines should be raised from six shillings to ten shillings per gallon, and on champagne and other sparkling wines from nine shillings to sixteen shillings per gallon.
