### LAND AND INCOME ASSESSMENT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. NGATA, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 2: To insert the following paragraph after paragraph (d):—

(dd.) By repealing the definition of "Maori," and substituting the following:—

"'Maori' means a person belonging to the aboriginal race of New Zealand, and includes a half-caste and a person intermediate in blood between half-castes and persons of pure descent from that race."

### [TRANSLATION.]

Tekiona 2: Me whakauru atu tenei rarangi ki muri iho i te rarangi (d):—

(dd.) Me whakakore te whakamarama o te kupu "Maori," a me whakakapi ki tenei:—

"Maori' tona tikanga he tangata no te iwi Maori o Nui Tireni, a e uru ana ki tera te hawhe-kaihe me te tangata waenganui ona toto i te hawhe-kaihe me te Maori tuturu."
