LOCAL AUTHORITIES LOANS CONVERSION BILL

Mr. O'REGAN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Whereas the Greymouth Harbour Board and the Westport Harbour Board have been authorised to raise the sums of two hundred thousand pounds and five hundred thousand pounds respectively for harbour-works at Greymouth and Westport respectively, and such sums are insufficient to adequately complete such works: Be it therefore enacted that, in the event of either of the said Boards converting its loans under this Act, the Governor, by Order in Council gazetted, may empower such Board to borrow, upon the same terms as for the purposes of effecting such conversion, such further sum, not exceeding ten per centum of the sum authorised to be raised as aforesaid, as he is satisfied is required for such works as aforesaid; and the gazetting of such Order in Council shall be conclusive evidence of the authority of the Board to borrow the amount named therein.
