

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

LAND BILL.

Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 36, line 27. After the word “commit” insert “or who the Board shall have reason to believe has at any time prior to the coming into operation of this Act committed, or aided, incited, or instigated any other person to commit.”

Clause 84, line 7. After the word “benefit” insert “and any person who has been guilty of any like offence prior to this Act coming into operation.”

And in same section, line 8. After the word “abetting” insert “or who has aided or abetted.”

Clause 86, line 45. After the word “declares” insert “or has wilfully declared.”

And in same section to add, at the end thereof,—

“If the land shall have been purchased for cash and the Crown grant has issued in the name of the purchaser, and the title has not been thereafter transferred to any other person, then such Crown grant shall be called in and cancelled, and the land comprised therein shall again become Crown land; but if the title has been transferred, then an amount equal to the original price shall be recoverable by the Board from the person guilty of making such false declaration.”
