HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

LAND BILL.

Dr. NEWMAN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

That five per centum of all lands now owned or hereinafter acquired by the Crown in the Provincial District of Wellington shall be set aside as an endowment for technical education.

ELECTORAL BILL.

Hon. Sir. J. HALL, K.C.M.G., in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

3A. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, no person being a female registered as an elector under this Act shall be entitled to vote at a parliamentary election until after the first day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three.

Mr. G. HUTCHISON, in Committee, to move the insertion of the following words, after the word "Registrar," in line 5, clause 23: "forthwith, upon the receipt of a claim made in accordance with this Act, to insert the particulars thereof in a list to be exhibited in some conspicuous place to which the public have access, which list shall notify the date of such claim having been received, and such particulars shall be retained on such list until the claim has been either accepted or rejected; it shall further be the duty of the Registrar."
