LAND FOR SETTLEMENTS ACT EXTENSION BILL.

New clause under consideration when progress was reported:—

A. (1.) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal Act or the amendments thereof, no land acquired under such Act or amendments shall, after the passing of this Act, be disposed of by or under lease in perpetuity.

(2.) All such land shall be open to selection for occupation with right to purchase in the same manner and subject to the like conditions as if such lands were rural lands under "The Land Act, 1892," and the amendments thereof. (*Mr. Baume.*)
