LAND FOR SETTLEMENTS ACT EXTENSION BILL.

Mr. Herries, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Confirmation of ease by a Native.

In the event of any lessee under the principal Act being a Native as defined by "The Native Land Court Act, 1894" (hereinafter called the said Act), the provisions of the said Act relating to confirmation of alienation and to alienation shall not apply in respect to lands contained in such lease, but such lessee shall have full power of alienation subject to the provisions of "The Land Act, 1892," and the principal Act.
