LOCAL GOVERNMENT AMENDMENT BILL NO. 3

*Proposed Amendments*

Mr D. MCKINNON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 3; Section 707C:* That section 707C (2) be amended by adding at line 27 the following words:

except that—

- (a) Two members shall be elected by the electors of the constituency that is the Franklin electoral district or, where that electoral district does not exist, the electors of the constituency that includes the greatest area of the Franklin electoral district as declared by the Governor-General by a Proclamation published in the *Gazette* of 1983 at page 1423:
- (b) Two members shall be elected by the electors of the constituency that is the Rodney electoral district or, where that electoral district does not exist, the electors of the constituency that includes the greatest area of the Rodney electoral district as declared by the Governor-General by a Proclamation published in the *Gazette* of 1983 at page 1423:

*Clause 4:* That subclause (3) be amended by adding at line 28 on page 10 the following words:

except that 2 members shall be elected by the electors of the constituency that is the Franklin electoral district and 2 members shall be elected by the electors of the constituency that is the Rodney electoral district.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of these amendments is that the electors of the Franklin and Rodney electorates will be able to elect 2 members of the Auckland Regional Authority in each case instead of one member as proposed. At present the electors of the equivalent areas elect 2 members of the Auckland Regional Authority.

Where in the future because of boundary or name changes those electorates cease to exist the electors of the electorates containing the largest part of those electorates will continue to have this right.
