LOCAL GOVERNMENT COMMISSION BILL

### Further Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Seath, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 25, subclause (3): To omit the word "regional", in line 36, and substitute the word "area".

Clause 28, subclause (2): To add the following proviso:

Provided that the Commission may in any particular case decide not to publish an explanatory statement if it considers it unnecessary in the circumstances.

Clause 29, subclause (4): To omit the words "sections 9 and 10", and substitute the words "sections 9, 10, and 10A".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 25 (3): This is a verbal amendment only, as the schemes referred to in the subclause are called area schemes and not regional schemes.

Clause 28 (2): This amendment adds the same proviso as is proposed to be added to clause 25 (3) relating to provisional local schemes. It will give to the Commission a discretion not to publish an explanatory memorandum in respect of a particular final local scheme if it considers it unnecessary in the circumstances.

Clause 29 (4): This amendment is consequential on the proposed new clause 10A (relating to the admissibility of evidence before the Commission), and will apply the same provisions where a proposal for a local scheme is being investigated by a committee.
