# Supplementary Order Paper

## Local Government Law Reform Bill (No 3)

*Proposed motion to divide Bill into 7 Bills*

Hon Chris Carter, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2* and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, the *Part 1* heading, and *clause 3* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Chatham Islands Council Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Chatham Islands Council Act 1995<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* and *Schedule IAA* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading and *clause 6* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Dog Control Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Dog Control Act 1996<sup>2</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

- (1) **Sections 13 and 13A** come into force on 1 November 2004.
- (2) **Section 18** (except in relation to **section 69A(2A)** of the principal Act) comes into force on 1 July 2006.
- (3) **Section 18** (in relation to **section 69A(2A)** of the principal Act) and the rest of this Act come into force on the day after the date on which the Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 21* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Local Electoral Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Local Electoral Act 2001<sup>3</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* and *Schedule 1A* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 4* heading and *clause 37* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Local Government Act 2002 Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Local Government Act 2002<sup>4</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4A* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 4A* heading and *clause 57C* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:****1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Local Government Act 1974 Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Local Government Act 1974<sup>5</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 5* heading and *clause 58* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987<sup>6</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 6* and *Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 6* heading and *clause 61* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

**The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:**

**1 Title**

- (1) This Act is the Local Government (Rating) Amendment Act **2004**.
- (2) In this Act, the Local Government (Rating) Act 2002<sup>7</sup> is called “the principal Act”.

**2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
