LOCAL GOVERNMENT (MEANING OF LOCAL AUTHORITY TRADING
ENTERPRISE) AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon MAURICE WILLIAMSON, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1974

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Local Government Act 1974 (“the principal Act”).
(2) This Act comes into force on 1 April 1999.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 4* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clauses:

An Act to amend the Income Tax Act 1994

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

- 1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Income Tax Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Income Tax Act 1994 (“the principal Act”).
- 2. Application**—This Act applies to the 1999–2000 and subsequent income years.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper divides the Local Government (Meaning of Local Authority Trading Enterprise) Amendment Bill into—

- (a) The Local Government Amendment Bill; and
- (b) The Income Tax Amendment Bill.
