LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. REED, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 5, subclause (2): To omit the words "the Board by valuation," and insert in lieu thereof the word "arbitration."

Clause 31: To omit the clause.

Clause 40, subclause (1): To omit the words "either" and "or compulsorily" in lines 47 and 48 respectively.

Clause 44, subclause (1): To omit all the words after the words "by way of sublease," and substitute the words "with right of purchase in the manner provided by Part III of the Land Act, 1908."

To move the following new clause:—

Power to sell
national
endowment.

A. (1.) Notwithstanding anything in the principal Act, it shall be lawful for the Board of the district in which any national-endowment land is situated to sell, with the consent of the Minister, and in such manner and on such terms as the Board and Minister think fit, any portion of such land which has been opened for selection and has not been selected within one year from the date of opening.

(2.) The purchase-money of land so sold shall be paid into the National Endowment Account.
