LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. SIDEY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 27A, subclause (12): To insert, after the word "section," the words "and every person deriving from such purchaser or lessee any interest in such land"; also to add at the end of the subclause the words "and to the acquisition by any such other person of any interest in such land as aforesaid. The provisions of sections three hundred and forty-two to three hundred and forty-seven of the Land Act, 1908, shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to the several limitations and prohibitions contained or implied in this section."

Clause 31, subclause (1): To omit the words "whether" and "or after."
