LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BUCHANAN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

To insert the following new clauses:—

Section 128 of
principal Act
amended.

A. Subsection one of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the principal Act, is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

“1A. Any selector of less than six hundred and forty acres of land under this Act, or under the provisions of any former Act, or any tenure may apply to the Board for an additional area of surveyed or unsurveyed land contiguous to the land in his selection, and the Board if it thinks fit, but subject to the limitations of this Act, may dispose of such land to the applicant without competition at such a price as the Board with the approval of the Minister may decide upon, and to hold the same on such tenure as the Board may approve.”

Section 129 of
principal Act
amended.

B. Section one hundred and twenty-nine of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the word “unsurveyed” in line 2, subsection one, and substituting the word “any” in lieu thereof.
