LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

To insert the following new clause:-

20n. It shall not be lawful for any person to acquire the lease of any reserve set apart for educational or any other public purpose or which forms part of any endowment belonging to any public body which, together with all other land of any description, owned, held, or occupied by him under any tenure (either severally or jointly, or in common with any other person) would exceed a total area of three thousand acres, calculated in manner provided by section ninety-seven of the principal Act.
